# **CAPIC (Comparative Agendas Project Issue Code)**

This is the core variable of the codebook. It is meant to code the 'policy content' of single units of analysis (sentences or quasi-sentences in the case of European Council Conclusions) with the aim of tracing issue attention. Each unit must be assigned one and only one of the topic codes from the list below.

Policy codes are organised in 'major topics' (e.g. major topic 1 is for Macroeconomics) and 'subtopics' (e.g. 101 is for Inflation, Prices, and Interest Rates). Coding is always done by applying the appropriate <u>subtopic</u>.

The last two digits identify single subtopics within major topics (e.g. 101, 103, and 104 are subtopics of major topic 1; 1403, 1408, 1420 are subtopics of major topic 14). Each topic has a --00 subtopic, which is used to code cases falling under more than one subtopics within the same major topic (e.g. a quasisentence about both labour market [103] and budget [105] will be coded 100) as well as cases falling under a major topic but not falling under any specific subtopic (e.g. a sentence about macroeconomics will be coded 100 too). Each topic also has a --99 subtopic, to be used to code cases falling within the major topic but not under any of the existing related subtopics.

A list of notes and/or examples is provided for some subtopics which appear harder to code.

The CAPIC variable captures no reference to tone and directionality.

#### 1. Macroeconomics

100 General Macroeconomic Issues (includes combinations of multiple subtopics)

NOTE: When sustainable development is the main topic of a sentence, it should be coded as either 100 or 700 depending on the emphasis (more on economic development or more on the environment and sustainability). When the emphasis is not clear a code 700 should be assigned.

NOTE: When the concept "aging population" is mentioned very generally or in connection with the economy it should be coded as 100.

NOTE: The EMU when mentioned generally should be coded here. Stage 2 of the EMU is also coded here, whereas Stage 1 is 1530 and Stage 3 is 104.

- 101 Inflation, Prices, and Interest Rates
- 103 Unemployment Rate
- Monetary Supply, European Monetary System (EMS), ECB, EIB, and the Treasury NOTE: General talk about Stage 3 of the Economic and Monetary Union are coded here.
- 105 Budget and Debt

NOTE: General references to budget implementation should be coded here. EXAMPLES: Stability and Growth Pact, "two-pack"

- 107 Taxation, Tax policy, and Tax Reform
- 108 Industrial Policy

NOTE: General references to productivity of the economy to be coded here (whereas international competitiveness of the EU economy should be coded 1806).

EXAMPLES: specific investment initiatives to support growth (e.g. by the EIB), restoring the normal lending of the economy, financing of the economy

NOTE: Discrimination on the labour market should be coded under 2: 200 or the specific

subtopic under 200 referring to the particular discriminated group.

NOTE: The topic of xenophobia should be coded here.

EXAMPLES: pesticide residues, authorisation of ingredients in foodstuffs, food labelling requirements related to safety, regulation of food additives, meat handling standards, authorisation of placing on the market of genetically modified products (GMO)

#### 404 Agricultural Marketing, Research, and Promotion

NOTE: This code refers to sales and advertising, not to scientific research. The latter should be coded 498.

### 406 Animal Welfare in Agriculture

EXAMPLES: space for chickens in cages, long-distance transport of animals NOTE: Animal welfare outside of agriculture (such as the protection of laboratory animals) goes under 709.

#### 1530 Creation of the Common/Single/Internal Market

The creation of a Common Market for specific products should go under the relevant subtopic (e.g. single market in pharmaceuticals under 321, common market in milk under 412, etc.).

NOTE: General references to the free movement of goods, capital and services within the EU should be coded here. Movements of workers should be coded 529.

NOTE: Stage 1 of EMU should be coded here.

#### 1540 Competition policy

NOTE: The EU competition policy deals with ensuring fair competition (i.e. rivalry between companies as a driving force of the market) in order to enhance economic growth. In particular, the policy deals with rule on mergers, takeovers, cartels (to be coded here) and the use of state aid (to be coded 1541). References to the competitiveness of the European economy should not be mistaken with competition policy (they are to be coded 1806).

#### 1541 State Aid (Preferential Public Assistance)

NOTE: Refers to aid from national governments to domestic enterprises or industries. Whenever the EU is providing aid this is part of the Cohesion and Regional Funds or the Agricultural Policy and should not be coded as state aid.

NOTE: This subtopic is meant for the regulation of specific products such as paint, pressure valves. In short all the technical requirements to harmonize the Internal Market.

#### 16. Defence

1600 General (includes combinations of multiple subtopics)

NOTE: General points about peace and security should be coded as 1600 both when they refer to the EU and to countries or regions outside the EU (in the second case with the respective ICC code).

NOTE: Petersbergs tasks should be coded here when mentioned generally.

- 1602 Defence Alliances and Security Assistance

NOTE: This code is for external alliances (such as NATO) and assistance to third countries. Peace-keeping operations as well as civilian/police missions should be coded here. While general matters of alliance go here, specific cases of military operations and missions must be coded under 1619.

- 1604 Military Capabilities and Coordination of Armed Services within the EU

- 1700 General (includes combinations of multiple subtopics)
  - NOTE: The Digital Agenda of the EU should be coded here unless a reference is made to a specific aspect of it which corresponds to a subtopic.

- 1704 Commercial Use of Space, Satellites
- 1705 Science Technology Transfer, International Scientific Cooperation NOTE: 1705 is for transfer and cooperation with third countries, not among EU member states.
- 1706 Telephone and Telecommunication Regulation
  NOTE: Includes infrastructure for high speed internet and other forms of
  telecommunications. Digital economy and Digital Single Market should be coded here.
- 1707 Newspaper, Publishing, and Broadcast Industry Regulation (TV, Cable, Radio)
  NOTE: This code refers to regulatory and technological aspects of media. Media contents
  should be coded 2303 (for written press), 2304 (for radio and television) or 2300 (for media in general).
- 1708 Weather Forecasting and Related Issues, Oceanography
- 1709 Computer Industry and Computer Security NOTE: Internet should be coded here.

### 18. Foreign Trade

NOTE: all subtopics under major topic 18 relate to external trade, i.e. trade with states outside the EU. Internal trade (i.e. among EU member states) goes into major topic 15 or subtopics in other major topic categories if specific products are at stake.

1800 General (includes combinations of multiple subtopics)

1802 Trade Negotiations, Disputes, and Agreements

NOTE: Topics referring to the World Trade Organisation (WTO) and other trade-related organisations should be coded as 1802 and not 1926.

NOTE: International trade agreements in agriculture should be coded 401.

1803 Export Promotion and Regulation

NOTE: International agricultural exports should be coded 401.

- 1804 International Private Business Investment and Corporate Development
- 1806 Productivity and Competitiveness of EU Business, EU Balance of Payments NOTE: References to the competitiveness of the EU economy should be coded here.
- 1807 Tariff and Import Restrictions, Import Regulation

NOTE: International agricultural imports should be coded 401.

- 1899 Other

### 19. International Affairs and Foreign Aid

NOTE: International Affairs will be coded applying the substantive topic code. Another variable (International Country Codes, ICC) will be used to code the countries, International Organisations, or international regions involved (if more than one country is involved and regional codes cannot be used, the ICC code 220 ("international") will be applied). If one MS, more than one MS, or the EU as a whole is also involved, the relevant code in the EUMS (EU and Member States) variable will also be applied.

1900 General (includes combinations of multiple subtopics)

NOTE: Independence and sovereignty of countries outside the EU should be coded here. NOTE: When the main topic in a sentence is Association Agreements, the sentence should be assigned code 1900 without a dummy for Enlargement. When Association Agreements are explicitly linked to Enlargement (and Enlargement is not the main topic), they should be coded 1900 plus the Enlargement dummy.

NOTE: The Common Foreign and Security Policy (CFSP) should be coded 1900 when mentioned generally.

1901 Foreign Aid

EXAMPLES: financial aid, technical assistance, development cooperation, humanitarian aid NOTE: Refers only to aid provided by governments or the EU.

NOTE: Pre-accession financial instruments, such as PHARE, should be coded 1901 plus the dummy for Enlargement.

- 1902 International Resources Exploitation and Resources Agreement EXAMPLES: international fishing agreements
- 1905 Developing Countries Issues (except financial issues)
  EXAMPLES: poverty, hunger, etc. in developing countries, Millennium Development Goals

NOTE: Topics referring to the World Trade Organisation (WTO) and other trade-related organisations should not be coded here but under 1802.

NOTE: This code is for international terrorism only. Domestic security concerns related to terrorism are coded 1227.

NOTE: Adoption of the acquis communautaire by states applying for EU-membership should be coded here.

#### 20. EU Governance and Government Operations

NOTE: Wherever "government" is used in major topic 20, the EU institutions are meant, not member state governments and their institutions.

2000 General (includes budget requests and appropriations for multiple departments and agencies)

NOTE: General references to the future of the Union are coded here.

2002 Government Efficiency and Bureaucratic Oversight

NOTE: Good governance should be coded here.

EXAMPLES: better lawmaking, "smart regulation", reduction of administrative burdens

  - NOTE: In an EU context, subtopic 2003 will mainly be about liberalization of postal markets.
- 2004 Government Employee Benefits, Civil Service Issues

NOTE: Currency refers only to the making of coins and bills, not the monetary issues related to these. The introduction of the Euro should go to under 104 but the making of the euro under 2006.

# **ICC (International Country Codes)**

References to third countries or geographic areas – International Affairs – are not coded in the 19 major topic of the CAPIC. International Affairs are rather coded by applying the relevant substantive topic code; this ICC variable is to be used to code the countries, International Organisations (IOs), or international regions involved [Note that codes 6-219 and 222-231 are for countries; codes 301-308, 311-315, 320, 325-326 and 330-334 are for regions; codes 501-516, 520-525 and 605 are for IOs]. As many as necessary ICCs are assigned to a single unit of analysis (quasi-sentence).

NOTES: If more than one country is involved and regional codes cannot be used, code 220 (international).

# **COHSPOL (Cohesion Policy)**

This dummy variable is to be used when specific arguments are related to cohesion policy. When Cohesion policy is mentioned in general, CAPIC 1420 is used.

EXAMPLES: an argument about EU funding of highways in lagging regions of EU Member States: CAPIC 1002 plus COHSPOL 1.

- O The argument is not related to cohesion policy
- 1 The argument is related to cohesion policy

COHSPOL 1 is always assigned when the CAPIC is 1420.

## **ENLG (Enlargement)**

This dummy variable is to be used when arguments are related to the enlargement of the European Union. Note that it is possible to code "Candidate countries" and "New Member States" with the EUMS variable.

EXAMPLES: an argument about the EU negotiating the chapter on fisheries with Estonia (as part of the accession talks): CAPIC 408 and EUMS 9 plus ENLG 1.

- O The argument is not related to enlargement
- 1 The argument is related to enlargement

ENLG 1 is always assigned when the CAPIC is 1980.

## **FP (Foreign Policy)**

This dummy variable is to be used when arguments are related to the foreign policy of the European Union. The dummy includes all quasi-sentences with CAPIC codes between 1900 and 1999 and all other quasi-sentences that can be considered as foreign policy and have been assigned the respective ICC code(s). Note that foreign trade issues (i.e. all codes between 1800 and 1899 and 401) are not captured by the foreign policy dummy.

- O The argument is not related to foreign policy
- 1 The argument is related to foreign policy
